**Election Moratorium and Meetings** – Suffolk County Council's first full council meeting under the new national administration was on Thursday 11<sup>th</sup> July. The Health Scrutiny Committee meets on 17<sup>th</sup> July and will consider Dentistry, Sexual Heath and Contraception Services for young people, and proposals for some Suffolk residents to use the new orthopaedic centre in Colchester to open later this year. The next meeting of the main Scrutiny Committee is on 23<sup>rd</sup> July when it will consider delivery under the new Highways Contract.

**Cranswick Chicken Expansion, Yaxley – Public Consultation** – Consultation has begun on linked plans to extend the processing facilities on the Eye Airfield and as a linked application to construct a 350,000m3 reservoir in Brome to supply water for the Waveney River. Two scoping opinions have been registered:

**DC/24/00513**|Request for a Scoping Opinion under Regulation 15 of the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 - Phase 2 processing factory (circa 31,000m2) and a new mill building

**DC/24/00515** | Request for a Scoping Opinion under Regulation 15 of the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2017 - Construction of a reservoir and associated pipeline.
